Pastor's Report to Congregation Council May 16, 2023

It's been yet another full month of ministry and activity here at St. Matthew! Let's start with worship. Since our last meeting we celebrated Compassion Sunday. Carol Elkins helped to lead much of the worship service, as well as offered us the opportunity to join in sponsoring a child abroad. It was a very moving service. Two weeks later the High School youth led the worship services, and we recognized those graduating from both high school and university. The high school graduates were presented with a gift book as well as their own copy of the ELW. This month we also welcomed 2 new communicants to the table with us, as they completed their instructions. It was announced that we will begin our worship schedule June 4.

The Christian education in the congregation is beginning to wind down as we approach the summer months. Between services we've had a couple of receptions, so the adults didn't meet on Sundays as often.
